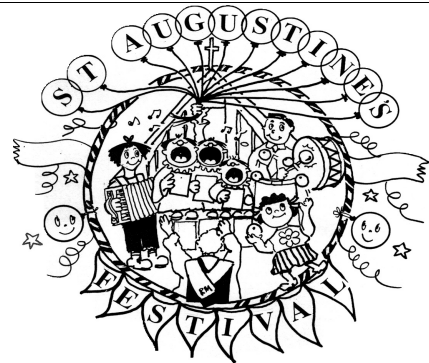
ARCHDEACON'S VISITATION
