Help poor communities grow a future. Helpers are needed to collect envelopes from 20 Houses during Christian Aid Week. If you can help please see Teresa Nichols.

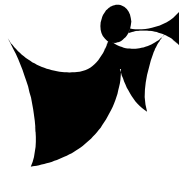
CONFIRMATION FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

The vicar would like to see any young people wishing to be confirmed, and their parents, after the service today. This is to arrange when the classes will be and when they will start.

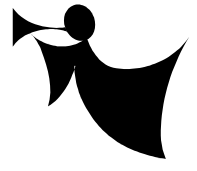

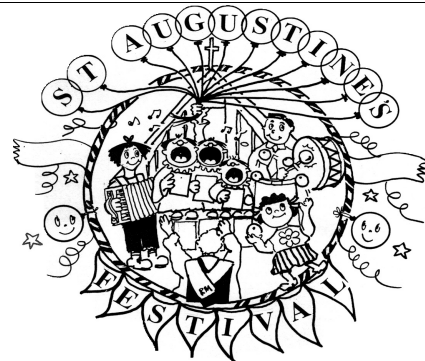
