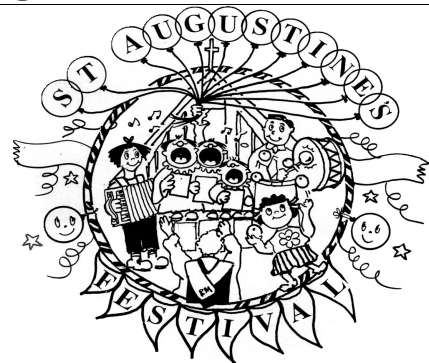
ORDINATION
