SERVICES

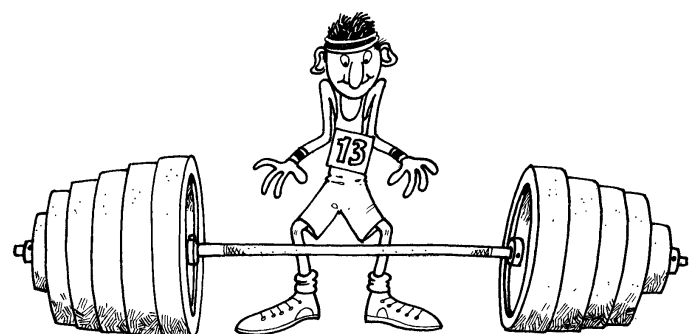
9.15 a.m. PARISH EUCHARIST
