The Songs Forever New. Lent and Easter meditations on Charles Wesley hymns, by Paul Wesley Chilcote. This book is a series of meditations of Charles Wesley Hymns.

He sets a **Biblical** passage alongside a different hymn for each day of the five weeks of Lent, and adds a commentary too.

Our Sound is our Wound by Lucy Winckett. This book is full of insights and is overflowing with ideas. There is pastoral and practical material and also an analogy between reading the Bible and playing music – “*Just as the score becomes music when the players take it up and play it, so the Bible only becomes scripture when we live it out in our own lives*”
